

Heavy rain claims two lives in coastal Karnataka

Heavy rain has claimed two lives in the coastal region of Karnataka.

The situation is still dangerous as the India Meteorological Department (IMD) has issued a red alert for the coastal districts of Dakshina Kannada, Udupi, and Uttara Kannada till 8.30 a.m. on Tuesday. According to the IMD forecast, the coastal region is likely to get extremely heavy rainfall, above 204.5 mm, till Tuesday morning.
